Webinar: *Ion-exchange chromatography in metabolomics: Exploring analytical performance and metabolome coverage*

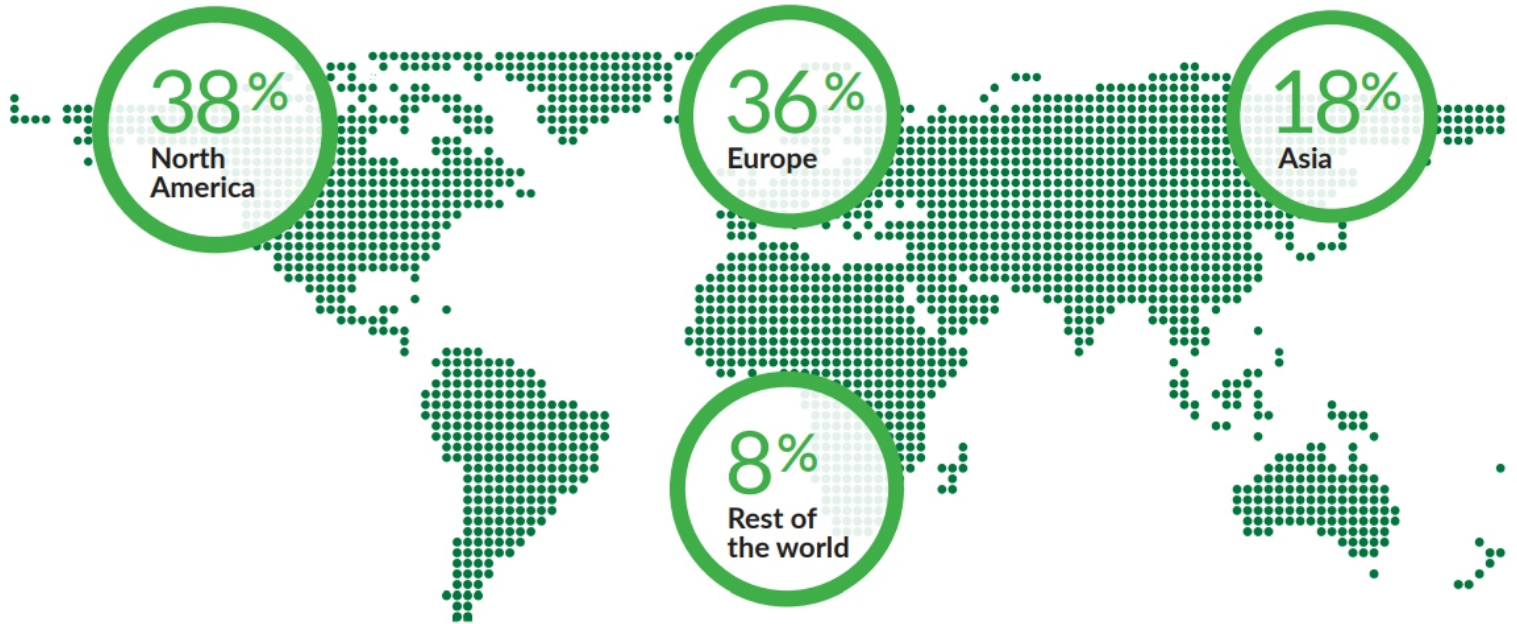
